Guidelines

Date

- 1 The need for a referral to an outside agency is identified by a teacher, therapy staff, parents or student.
- 2 Decisions as to the most appropriate service are made in consultation with the family, HOD or the appropriate staff member.
- 3 Teacher or therapy staff will seek informed consent of the student or parent.
- 4 Procedures, as determined by the relevant agency, are followed to complete the referral process, and a copy is retained in the student file.
- The implementation of any recommendations from the agencies, will be the decision of the HOD of the ISC after consideration of the student's best interests and within the available resources of the College.
