- 1. To interview or screen volunteers or trainees to ensure they have appropriate understanding and knowledge of needs for students with disabilities.
- 2. To engage volunteers and trainees in appropriate professional development as required.

Guidelines

- 1. Volunteers and trainees will be interviewed by the HOD and appropriate staff members.
- 2. All volunteers will have references checked and have a police vet check carried out.
- 3. All trainees will have had a police vet from their place of study and references provided.
- 4. An induction programme will be provided for volunteers and trainees by the relevant teacher or therapist.
- 5. Volunteers and trainees will be provided specific tasks as set by the HOD and/or their professional supervisor, which will be monitored by a teacher or therapist.
