MORE ABOUT THIS ASSESSMENT

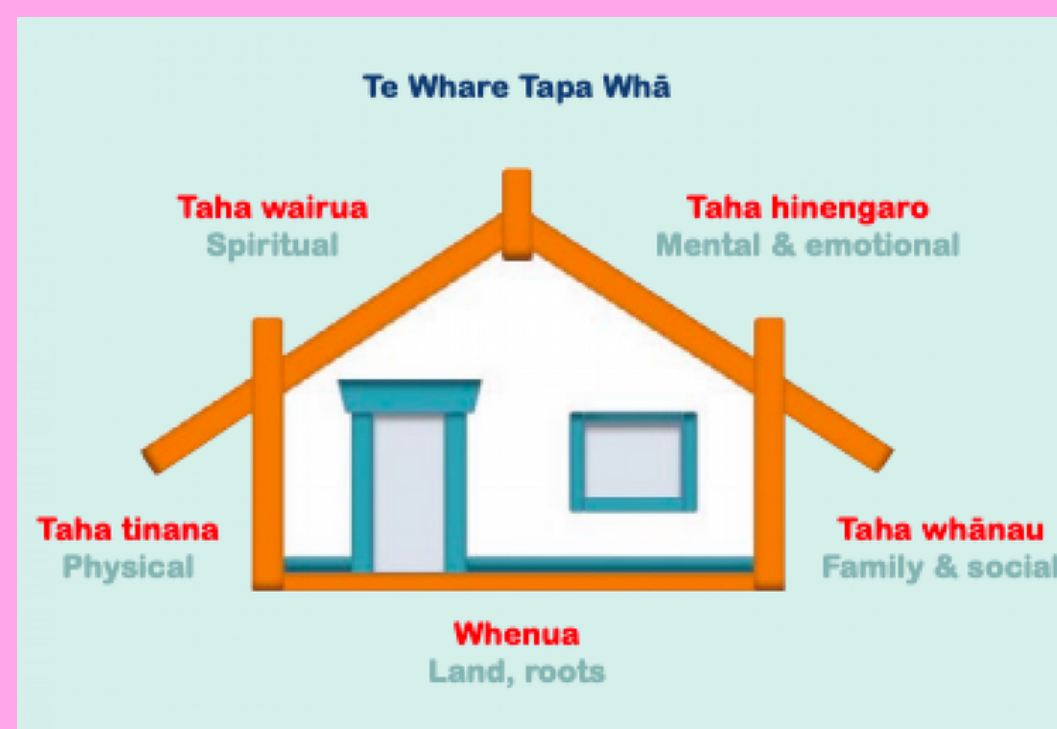
The HEEADSSS assessment is a supportive kōrero that explores all areas of a student's health and wellbeing. Widely used in Aotearoa New Zealand and internationally, it helps to identify strengths and any areas where support may be helpful while respecting each student's privacy and encouraging open, honest conversation.

THIS ASSESSMENT INCLUDES:

A general health check (such as height, weight, blood pressure, vision & hearing) along with friendly health advice and support to help your young person stay well and thrive.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

We use the Māori health model Te Whare Tapa Whā, which looks at wellbeing in a holistic way - physical, mental and emotional, social (whānau), and spiritual. By checking in across all these areas, we can better support our rangatahi to feel well, stay engaged in learning, and grow into healthy confident young people.
